Re: Cork Primary Schools Tennis Programme 2018/19

Munster Ireland and Cork Sports Partnership have teamed up to roll out a new School Badminton Programme in 2018. The programme will operate for a limited number of Cork primary schools during the 2018/19 school year.

The aim of this primary schools programme is to introduce pupils from 2nd & 3rd classes (Boys, Girls & Mixed) to the Sport of Tennis in a supportive, structured, social and enjoyable environment. In return for full commitment to the programme, each school will receive a **4 week Coaching Session**.

This programme is valued at over €400 per school and is heavily subsidised by Cork Sports Partnership and Tennis Ireland. The **programme will cost each school €8 per pupil** to take part in which will be payable upon acceptance to the programme.

Cork Schools Tennis Programme 2018/19 – Application Process

Steps involved in the Application Process

Step 1: School registers its 2nd or 3rd classes to participate in the Primary Schools Tennis Programme by completing the programme registration form.

Step 2: Registration will be acknowledged by Cork Sports Partnership.

Step 3: Successful schools will be contacted by Cork Sports Partnership to confirm acceptance on to the programme and invoiced €8 per pupil to take part. Unsuccessful schools will be placed on a waiting list for future phases of the programme.

Step 4: Following receipt of payment, the Tennis Ireland coach will contact all successful schools to arrange suitable training days in the school.

Step 5: The Tennis coach will deliver the 4 training sessions (45 mins each) as agreed with school
