Equipment Provisions and Resources: The fund will be used to purchase hand sanitiser and some scale sports equipment for the family fun days.

Communication and Marketing: We will use the funding to get a local videographer to make a promotional video for the complex to let the community know what activities and facilities are available for them to use.

The fund will support our facility to reopen once restrictions are lifted. The training and education opportunity will allow us to upskill some of our volunteers. To be able to provide the older adults with

the opportunity to get out and active will benefit their physical and mental health by supporting them to out and active in a safe and sociable environment.
